3. Type of event:

This is a basic level co-driver school that will focus on fundamental skills. The format will follow a walk-through of an event from start to finish, covering all aspects of an event. The event will be run on stages consisting of Hardwood, linoleum, concrete, dirt/mud, grass and gravel. The elevation of the stages is approximately 3,557 ft or 1,084 m

4. Jurisdiction:

This event is not a part of any championship nor is it officially recognised by any Sanctioning body. It is put on by Leanne Junnila and Keith Morison in conjunction with the Calgary Sports Car Club. The event will reference the CARS National Rally Regulations and the Western Canada Rally Championship Rules.

5. Entry Fees

\$75 per person, Early Entry (registration received before May 4, 2359h)

\$100 per person, Late Entry (registration received after May 4, 2359h)

Entries will be accepted until the end of registration at 1230 MDT, Saturday May 8, 2010.

To be eligible for early entry fees your completed registration must be submitted, with payment, before midnight on May 4, 2010.
